

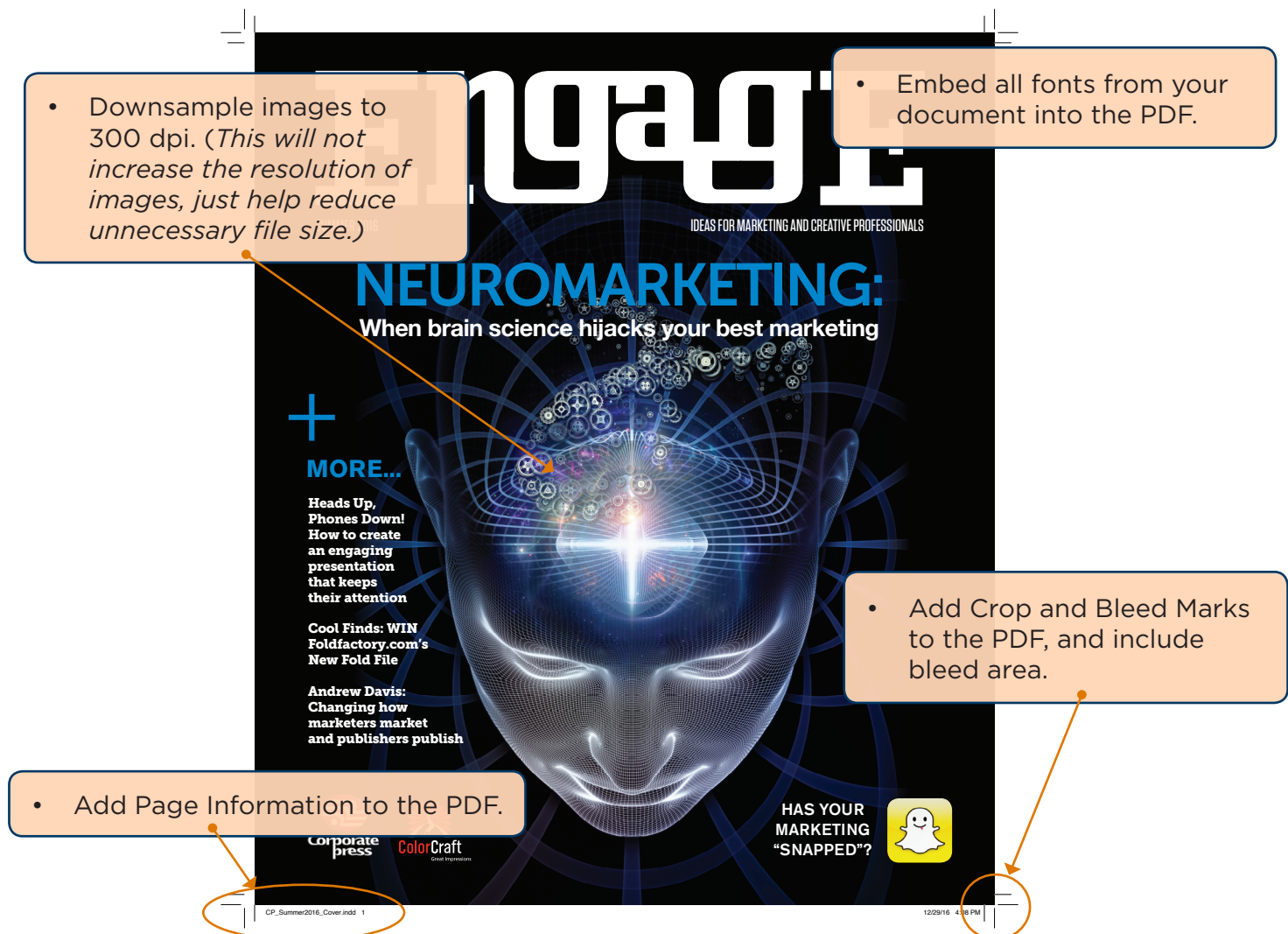
Creating PDF's using the Corporate Press PDF Export Preset for InDesign

Importing the Corporate Press PDF Export Preset

These steps describe how the **'Corporate Press.joboptions'** file will be imported into the **InDesign Adobe PDF Preset** list.

(The file is included in the same folder as this how-to guide.)

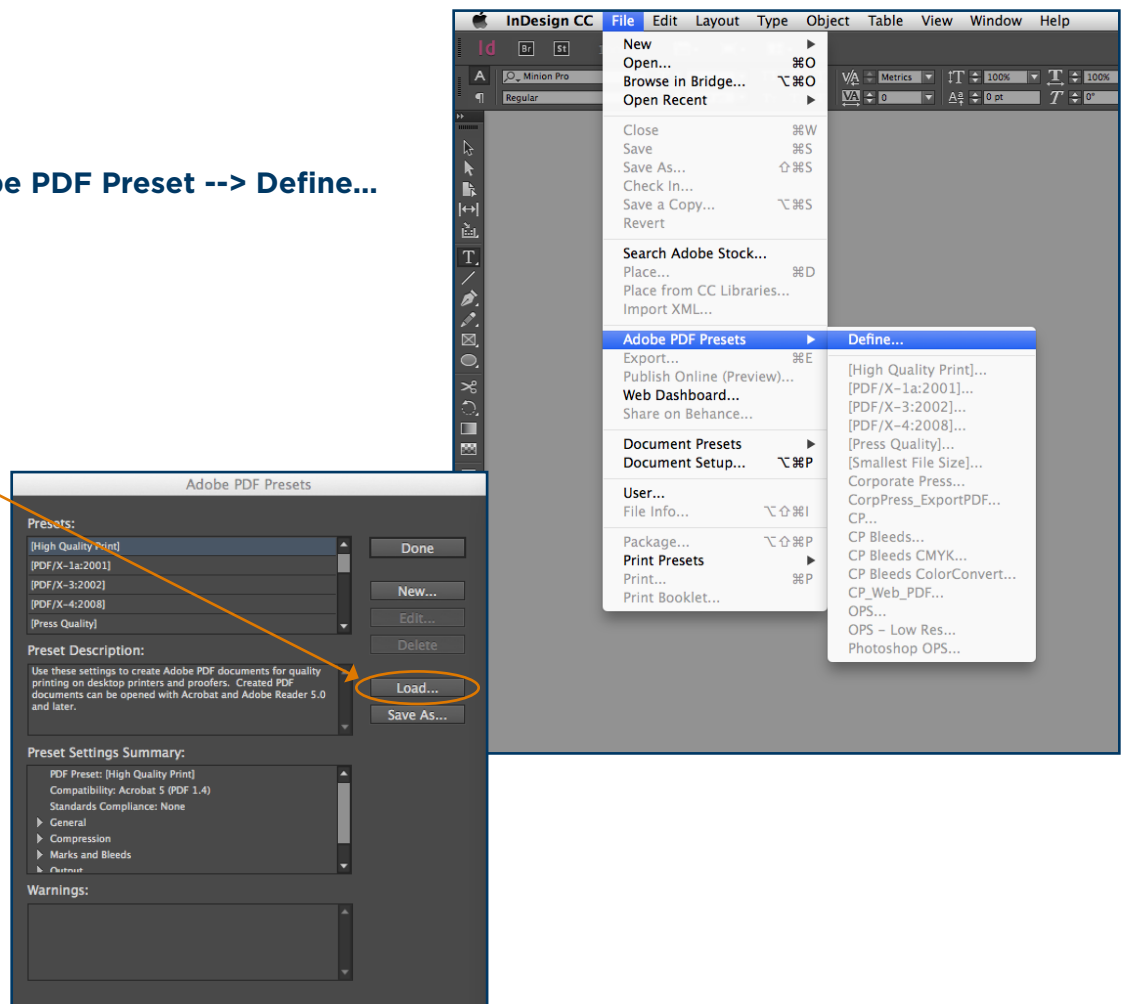
We will be using InDesign CC 2015 on the Mac in this example.

(The process is nearly identical using CS3 - CC2015 and on Windows.)

1: Go to: **File --> Adobe PDF Preset --> Define...**

2: Click on **Load...**

Browse to where you saved the downloaded preset, select the file and click **Open**.



3: Click **Done**. That's it!

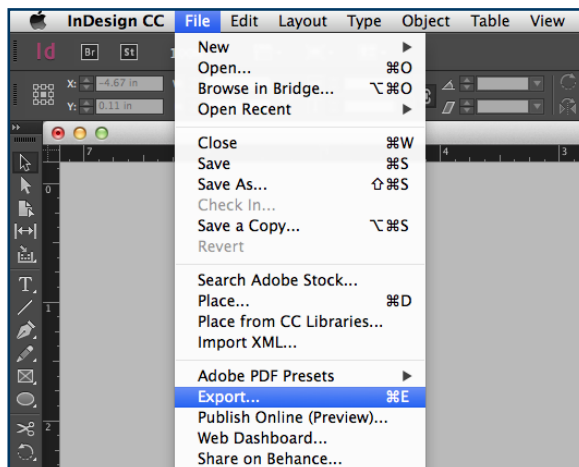
Now the **Corporate Press** preset will be available in the list of presets in the **Export Adobe PDF** dialog box.

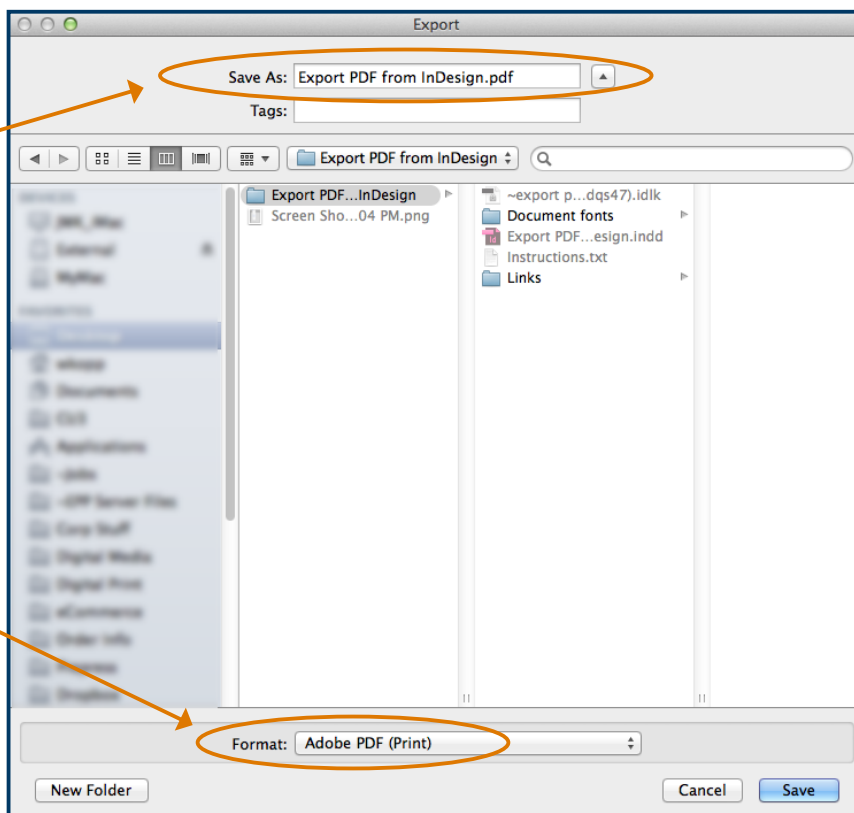
Export your PDF using the Corporate Press PDF Preset

Now that your preset is loaded, you are ready to export your pdf file. Once your document is ready to send to us, use this preset to create your print-ready PDF.

1: Go to: **File --> Export...**



2: Navigate to the location you want to save your **PDF**. Enter a filename in the **Save As:** box and click **Save**.



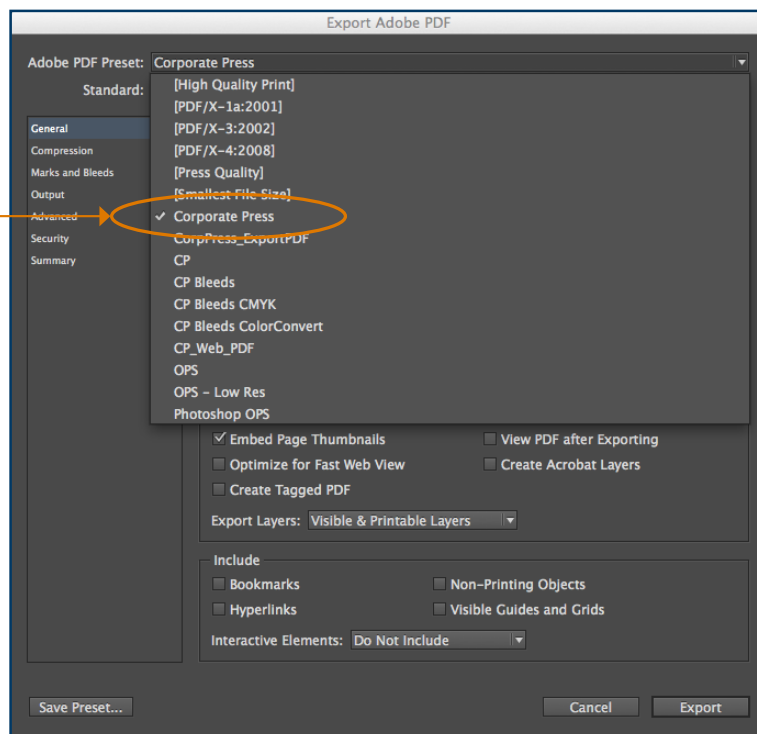
Choose **Adobe PDF (Print)** from the **Format** list...

Export your PDF using the Corporate Press PDF Preset (cont.)

- 3: In the **Export Adobe PDF** dialog box, make sure you have **Corporate Press** chosen from the **Adobe PDF Preset:** options, then click **Export**.

Your **PDF** is now ready for print!
